

Trekking Volcán Osorno, Paso Desolación Vicente Pérez Rosales National Park



Start at: Puerto Varas, 8:30 am
Ends at: Puerto Varas, 18:30 pm
Location: Volcán Osorno, Región de Los Lagos, South of Chile.
Difficulty level: Medium
Duration: 8-9 hours in total, 2 hours in the van go and back.
Meal: Box lunch with sandwich, fruits and water.
Transportation: Inclusive.
Equipment you need: Trekking shoes, rain jacket, sun protection (sunglasses, hat) water bottle.
Guide: Inclusive, English, German and Spanish is spoken, with first aid knowledge and expert in native flora and fauna.
Safety: Inclusive, personal insurance. Emergency equipment by an breakdown.

Full day excursion. Six hours trekking in total, surrounding the cone of the volcano up to Lago Todos Los Santos.

We depart at 8:30 AM from Puerto Varas and take route 225, going along the southern edge of Lago Llanquihue. We will go through Ensenada and Saltos de Petrohué, a beautiful place where we stop and see the rivers and the waterfalls.

When we reach Petrohué, we start the trekking, going up for 3 hours, and enjoy one of the most amazing views of the Andes Mountains.

At our feet we will see 3 volcanoes and one of the most beautiful Chilean lakes. After this, 3 hours down until we reach the shore of Lago Todos Los Santos.
